## Anderson Avenue

### Sanitary Sewer Replacement

#### Project

**Description:** The City's contractor, *Mid-Atlantic Utilities, Inc.*, will be replacing the eight-inch sewer main and three manholes on Anderson Avenue between Forest Avenue and Laird Street. Work to replace the sanitary sewer pipe and manholes will begin the week of Aug. 12, weather permitting. The existing 378-foot sewer is in disrepair and the City of Rockville's Department of Public Works determined that the sewer pipe's condition warranted replacement.

During the sanitary sewer main construction, your drinking water or sanitary sewer services will not be interrupted. Traffic flow along Anderson Avenue may experience some temporary delays as the contractor proceeds with the work. Access to your homes and driveways will not be affected. Impacts during construction may include temporary lane closures, on-street parking restrictions, and construction noise. Signs will be posted to notify motorists and residents of temporary parking restrictions and lane closures. No trees will be removed as part of this project.

**Purpose:** Replacement of damaged sanitary sewer main.

**Location:** Anderson Avenue between Forest Avenue and Laird Street (see reverse side of this advisory for a map of the affected area).

**Timeline:** The work is expected to be completed within four weeks from the start of construction on Aug. 12, weather permitting.

**Cost:** \$80,000 (estimated project cost)

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
