

Streetlight Improvements Comment Period

Coleman Park Lane

Project Description: In an effort to improve area lighting, the City of Rockville seeks to add streetlights on Coleman Park Lane. City staff has evaluated the existing lighting on Coleman Park Lane and propose to add two new lights through this effort: one at the end of the road and another near the intersection with Grandin Avenue.

Purpose: The City of Rockville is currently in the process of coordinating with Pepco and the City's streetlight contractor, Lighting Maintenance, Inc. to proceed with this project. This project is funded by the City's Streetlighting Improvements Capital Improvements Program, which has the objective to provide adequate lighting on public streets to enhance traffic and pedestrian safety and to help provide security.

Timeline and Process: Coordination with Pepco is necessary as Pepco will be providing power to the lights. The work would also involve Lighting Maintenance, Inc. who would install the two poles and fixtures to match the existing light and install plastic pipe underground that would house and protect the power cable. Completion of this project is expected within three to six months.
