- Develop and stimulate public awareness and achievement in environmental progress in Rockville
- Recognize leadership and innovation in "green" development and in individual and corporate environmental stewardship
- Recognize and promote the efforts of Rockville's citizens and businesses in bettering our local and regional environment

Eligibility

- Residents and businesses within the City of Rockville
- Businesses, community groups, nonprofits, and any other organization conducting / executing projects within or benefiting the City
- Schools/school groups located within the City
- City/County/State municipal operations within the City

Recipients and their projects may at the City's discretion be described and presented in press releases, web pages, brochures, and/or other publications.

Nominations & Selection

- Nominations will be accepted year-round on a rolling basis
- Nominations will be reviewed by the Commission on the Environment and appropriate City staff
- Mayor and Council will make final selection based upon Commission recommendations

Nominations will be judged on the basis of:

- Demonstrated personal or organizational commitment to the environment that has produced measurable, positive change
- Enthusiasm and resourcefulness in educating and inspiring others
- Development and implementation of projects that show outstanding merit and innovation in environmental conservation, protection, preservation, or pollution prevention
- Extent to which project/endeavor goes beyond normal practices or exceeds standard requirements

Presentation of Award

- An Environmental Excellence Award plaque will be presented by the Mayor and the Chair of the Environment Commission at a televised City of Rockville Mayor and Council meeting.
