(Accomplishments or deeds may have been performed in or out of school, may be academically-related, sports-related, or something the student has done as part of a club or other group, for instance.)

In answering, please cover the following:

A. Describe the accomplishment or deed:

B. Describe the impact the accomplishment or deed had on the person, persons, or surrounding community.

C. Describe any special qualities, creativity, and/or resourcefulness that the student demonstrated in performing this accomplishment or deed.

E. How did the student demonstrate the “moral courage” required to do the right thing even when difficult, in this accomplishment or deed?
