The proposed amendments would comprehensively revise and amend Chapter 5 of the Rockville City Code entitled “Buildings and Building Regulations,” by amending certain provisions to “Numbering of Buildings”, and “Dangerous Buildings”; by adopting with certain additions, deletions, and amendments the ICC International Building Code (2009 Edition), The ICC International Residential Code (2009 Edition), the NFPA National Electrical Code (2008 Edition), the ICC International Energy Conservation Code (2009 Edition), The ICC International Plumbing Code (2009 Edition), ICC International Existing Building Code (2009 Edition), the ICC International Mechanical Code (2009 Edition) the ICC International Fuel Gas Code (2009 Edition), The National Fire Protection Association NFPA 51 (2007 Edition), the National Fire Protection Association NFPA 54 (2009 edition), the National Fire Protection Association NFPA 58 (2008 Edition); and by otherwise adding a new article XIII, entitled “Existing Building Code” (2009 Edition); and by adding a new Article XIV, entitled “Green Building Regulations.”
