The Allnut House [also known as the Sante-Allnut House] was built in 1890. It is one of the first houses built in Henry Copps' 520-acre subdivision known as "West End Park." Henry C. Allnut was the register of wills, according to the U.S. Census of 1900. A large Victorian home, it features asymmetrical massing, a corner tower and a wrap-around porch with spindle decoration. This property is also listed in the National Register of Historic Places.
