



The Bingham-Brewer House, built in 1821, is one of the oldest buildings in Rockville. It is a substantial brick Federal style house, associated with people who have exercised leadership roles in the city. Julius Bingham, editor of the second Rockville paper; William McClenahan, organizer of Rockville Christian Church; members of the Veirs family (local landholders); and members of the Brewer family (attorneys influential in local politics) have all lived here.
