This Victorian frame house was built ca. 1893 in the Rockville Park subdivision on the east side of the B & O railroad tracks. The property originally consisted of three lots, and from 1911 - 1971, it was owned by members of the Kingdon family (first Carey and Hattie Kingdon, and then by Carey's sister, Mary R. Kingdon). The Victorian house features strong cross gables with decorative shingles in the gable ends, and coved cornices on south and east facades.
