The Cook-Waters-Lewis House is named for the African-American families who have lived here. This unique urban townhouse was built soon after 1894 by George and Fannie cook in what was then the new subdivision of Lincoln Park. The brick building has decorative details at the cornice and over the window and door openings on the front façade.
