The Corrick-Robertson House is a Victorian Gothic Revival style house constructed in 1893. Notable features include the prominent front gable, the two-story side bay with a polygonal first floor and a square bay above, and floor-to-ceiling windows at the front parlor. This was one of the early homes built in the Rockville Park subdivision. It was built by M. Cronise for Mr. Charles J. Corrick of Rockville. The Robertsons purchased the property in 1927 and lived here for many years.
