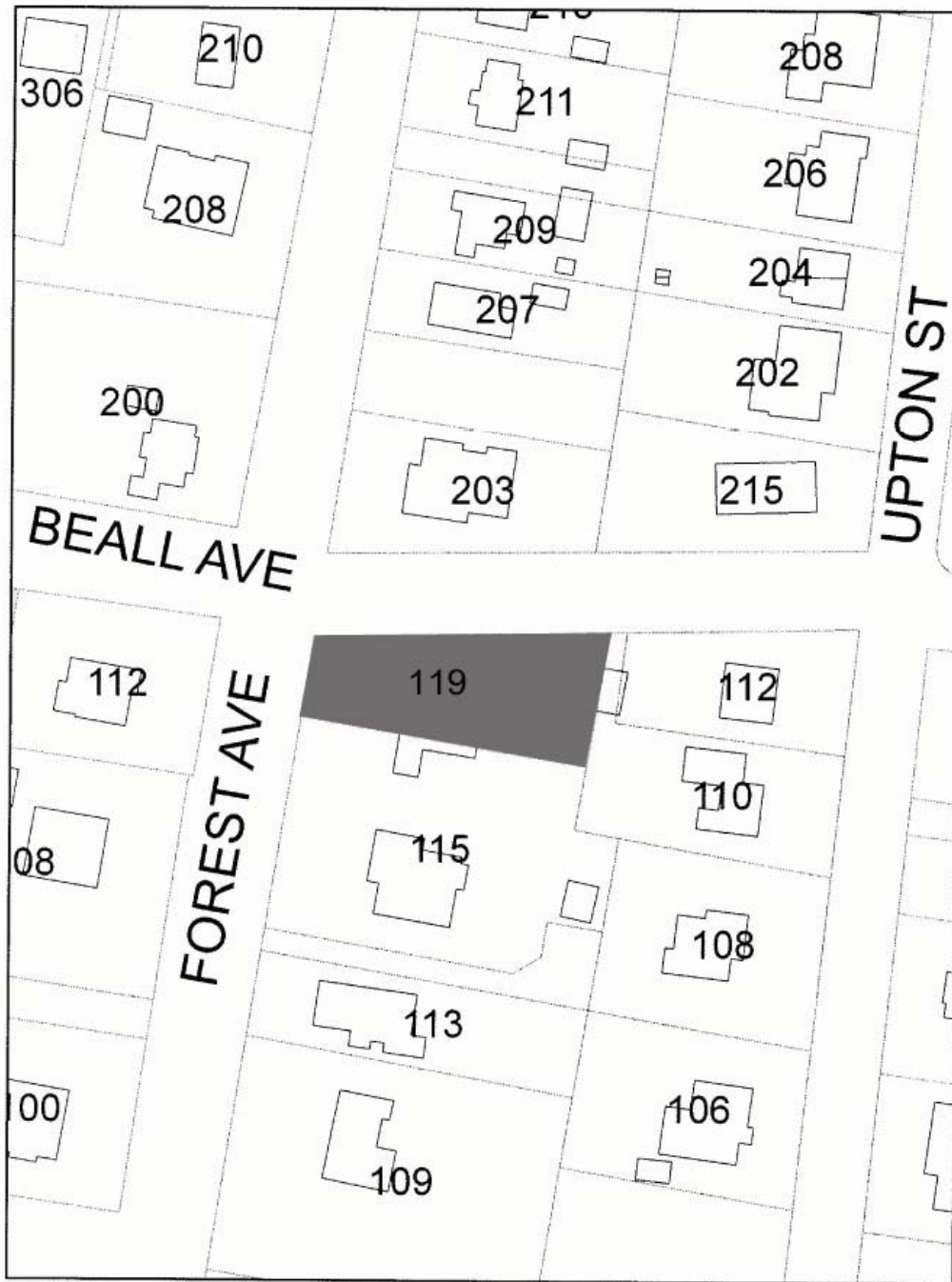


Designated 2002



This Tudor-Revival style house was built for Judge Donald Delashmutt and his wife, Elizabeth in 1928. The architect was John W. Kearney of Washington, D.C. and the builder was Frank Karn of Rockville. It was unusual at that time in Rockville to hire an architect. The building also illustrates the translation of high style design to a more simple and compact form. It has many picturesque elements, including the cast stone surrounds with Tudor arch openings and side quoins, roofing details, roof garden and asymmetrical massing.
