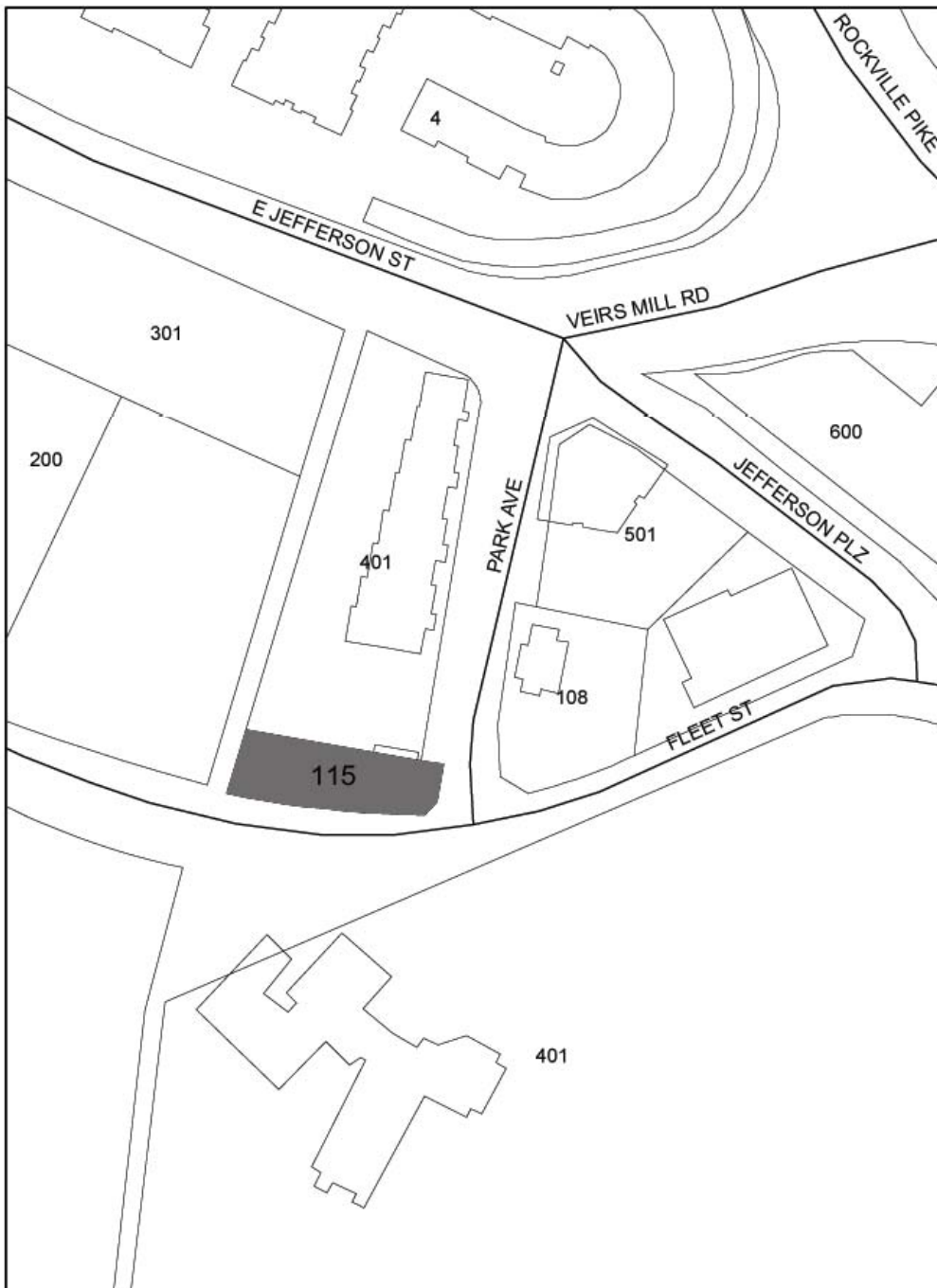


Designated 2003



The Spates Bungalow was built in 1923 and is an excellent example of the Craftsman style Bungalow offered through early 20th century pattern books. It appears to be the Kilbourne model from the Sears Catalogue. This building was built for J. Roger Spates, City Mayor from 1926 to 1932, by the local builder, Henry Howes. This is only one of two remaining structures in The Park subdivision (platted in 1888 by Judge William Veirs Bouic).
