



This Historic District includes major elements of the late 19th century Town of Rockville, including residential neighborhoods, local churches, an associated church cemetery, educational facilities (Rockville Academy), and the early hotel property that became a nationally-recognized psychiatric hospital (Chestnut Lodge). The district extends north and south along the spine of West Montgomery Avenue, and includes a fine collection of Victorian frame homes as well as a few earlier mid-19th century homes.
