

Sidewalk Construction Notice

Work to Begin Week of Oct. 31

Project

Description: The City of Rockville will construct a new four-foot concrete sidewalk behind the existing curb to the most recent Americans with Disabilities Act accessibility standards. The existing fire hydrant near Big Oak Court will be relocated. Parking restrictions and temporary lane closures may be in place during this work. Part of the Sidewalk Capital Improvement Program, this project is consistent with the 2020 Mayor and Council vision, Multimodal Transportation, which seeks to improve pedestrian safety throughout the community.

Purpose: To enhance pedestrian accessibility, safety and mobility.

Location: The west side of Monroe Street between Big Oak Court and Cabin John Parkway (see attached map).

Timeline: Starting the week of Monday, Oct. 31, and continuing for approximately two weeks

Cost: The project has an estimated cost of \$35,000.
