

Maple Alley Drainage Improvement Project

Community Meeting

Project Description: As part of the City of Rockville Storm Drain Rehabilitation and Improvements project within the Capital Improvements Program, the Department of Public Works (DPW) will be improving the drainage within the Maple Alley right-of-way east of First Street. The improvements will reduce standing water and the periodic flooding that could cause damage to the surrounding private properties. Maple Alley will be modified to channel the water to a new storm drain inlet, and new pipes will be installed to convey the water to the storm drain system on Denham Road. The project will upgrade portions of the storm drain system in Denham Road to provide capacity for the additional stormwater flow from Maple Alley. A map of the project limits is included on the back of this page.

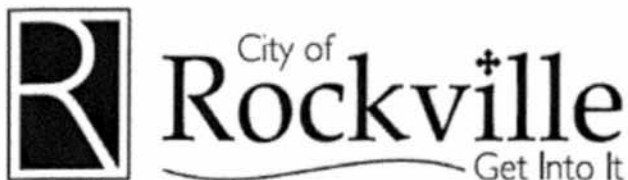

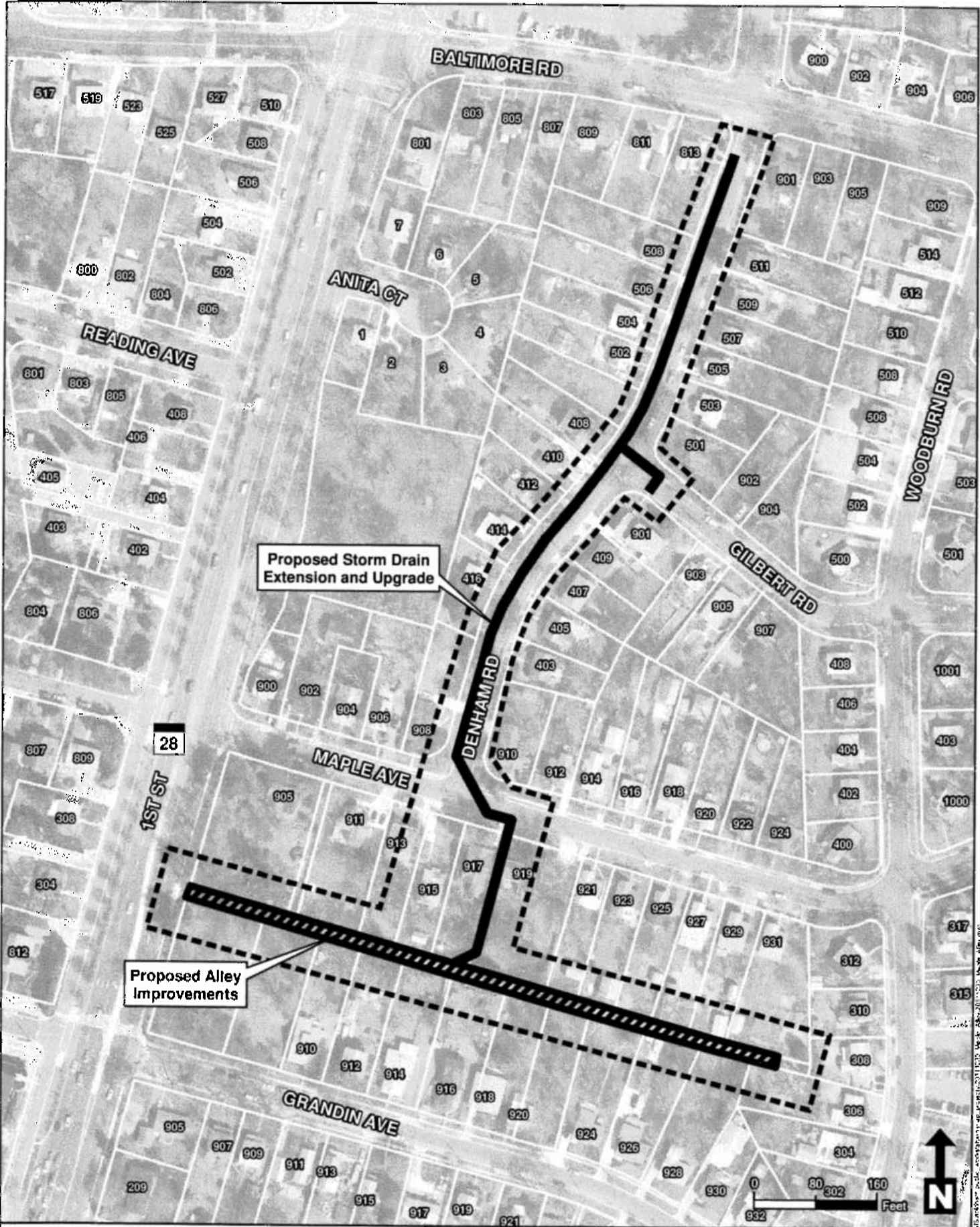
Timeline: The design is scheduled for completion in the spring. Construction is anticipated to begin in the fall.
