Administrative:

- Attended Traffic and Transportation Commission meeting on 6/24/08. (CS)
- Completed and sent out a Neighborhood Advisory for Grandin traffic management project. (EE)
- Met with Montgomery County on 6/26/08 to discuss Tax Impact Credit. (EE/RT)
- Completed three staff evaluation and returned them to PW Administrator. (EE)

Traffic Engineering/Operations:

- Turning movement counts to date 20
- Mechanical counts to date 73
- Checked traffic signal at Rockville Pike/Halpine Road. SHA is completely upgrading underground and overhead signal components.
- Turned-off all school flasher - Five locations.
- Picked up mechanical counter at Carnation Drive and sent copy to Senior Center.
- Reset speed sign EB Wootton Parkway/Wootton High School entrance.
- Replace a streetlight fixture between 7 & 8 Lakeside Overlook.
- Traffic signal at W. Gude Drive/Gaither Road: Installed 15 amp breaker box for red-light camera.
- Met with contractor to review wiring replacement at N. Stonestreet Avenue/Park Road.
- Responded to traffic signal request at Seven Locks Road/Fortune Terrance: loop is not working.
- Jefferson Street/Halpine Road: Contractor saw-cut loops on Halpine Road.
- Checked no voltages on W. Montgomery Avenue/Great Falls Road/Jefferson Street.
- Issued work orders to modify parking restrictions on Preserve Pkwy, and Autumn Wind Way

Development Review:

- 1) Twinbrook Commons: Staff met with the applicant at DRC to discuss the proposed driveway access on Chapman Avenue of the existing surface parking area near the intersection of Halpine. (RT/NS)
- 2) Upper Rock Development: Staff reviewed the signature set and provided minor comments to Planning. (RT)
- 3) Fallsgrove Office northeast of Gude and MD28 intersection: Staff received on 6/27 responses to DRC comments. (NS/RT)
- 4) Beall Grant II Apartments – N. Washington Street: Staff is working on the transportation report. The Use Permit is scheduled to go to Planning Commission on 7/23/08. (RT/NS)

CIP:

Baltimore Road (NS)

This is a CIP project to improve the east side of Baltimore Road between MD 28 and City limits. Staff assigned weights to the RFP evaluation criteria. Technical and Financial proposals were received from the four short-listed firms. Consultant Review Committee is scheduled to meet on Wednesday 7/2.

Red-Light cameras (EE)

- The two new red-light camera locations will officially operate on July 1, 2008.

Sidewalks:

- Beall Avenue: Phase III construction is underway. (JW/CS)
