1. General Announcements, Introduction of Guests and Public Comment Period

- a. Chair Kaplan called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

2. Draft Report for Transit Gap Analysis Study

- a. Mr. Kotov, Senior Transportation Planner, presented draft report for Transit Gap Analysis Study.

3. Review and Approve April 2019 Meeting Minutes

- a. Commissioner Kaplan made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Griffiths to approve the April 2019 meeting minutes. The motion passed.

4. Staff Report and Updates

- a. Staff provided the Monthly Report.

5. Additional Items

- a. Commissioner Plante requested staff to look into the intersection of W Edmonston Drive and Wootton Parkway. Due to increased traffic from the new Bayard Rustin Elementary School, more right-turning vehicles are now queuing on eastbound W Edmonston Drive (before the intersection with Wootton Parkway) because they are unable to maneuver around vehicles waiting at the signal to make the left turn onto Wootton Parkway.
- b. Commissioner Gibney added that similar issues (to W Edmonston Drive and Wootton Parkway) are occurring at the exist from Shady Grove Metro onto Redland Road as well as at the Metro Station Road and MD 355. These issues were brought up by the Commission during a meeting with WMATA's Government Relations Officer several months ago, but still have not been addressed. Commissioners decided to draft a letter to the City's elected officials to request assistance with WMATA's response.
