Dear Customers:

As many of you know, work has been ongoing in preparation for the Locker Rooms and Lobby Renovation Project. We are happy to announce that the Mayor and Council approved a Bid Award to City Construction, LLC and a contract has been fully executed for this project's construction. Construction work is expected to begin in March, with an estimated one-year timeline for completion. Although this project will incur short term inconveniences, and alterations to how customers use the Rockville Swim and Fitness Center, it is important to remain positive as the work to the facility is needed and welcomed to improve the Swim and Fitness Center.

This winter's initial phases of construction will have minimal impact on facility's operations. The majority of work to the existing lobby and locker rooms will be completed in the summer phase, between May and September. While we do plan to keep the indoor pools and fitness rooms open with minimal interruptions, **all customers should plan to enter the facility from the outdoor pool's entrance and use the outdoor pool's bathhouse between May - September 2019.** We recognize that this is a major change for some users and are in the planning process to ensure we minimize any complications of the change.

Stay tuned for more information on the upcoming closure of the indoor locker rooms and lobby, as well as our corresponding temporary access plans which are scheduled to commence on 5/1/19. It is very important to monitor your email and/or the website for developments as some may occur within a short timeframe.

We will continue to share information, including updated facility access plans via the Swim and Fitness Center's email group (sign-up online at www.rockvillemd.gov/swimcenteralerts), and by notices posted at the facility and online. Thank you in advance for your continued support, patience and understanding as we work to improve experiences at the facility.
