Police Crime Report

For the Week Ending – June 2, 2019

The Rockville City Police Department would like to provide residents with some **crime prevention theft from auto tips**:

- Remove all valuables from your vehicles (to include: GPS, iPod, chargers, EZ-passes, purses and wallets, etc.).
- Remove your keys from the ignition.
- Lock your car. Take your keys and/or key fob with you. Do not keep the key fob near the vehicle.
- Do not hide or store spare keys or fobs in your vehicle.
- Make sure your windows have been rolled up completely and sunroof is closed before securing your vehicle.
- Park in well-lighted areas.
- When parking in attended lots or parking garages, leave only the ignition key with the attendant. (Many vehicles have a “valet” key, which limits the areas in your vehicle that can be accessed.)
- Park as close as possible to an open business.
- If you have a garage, use it.
- Close and lock your garage.
- Many vehicles come with alarms that sound only if the vehicle door is opened when the alarm has been set. Consider upgrading your vehicle’s alarm with a system that responds to glass breakage.
- Call the police immediately if your vehicle has been broken into or tampered with – **DO NOT TOUCH THE VEHICLE – THIS WILL CONTAMINATE THE SCENE AND PREVENT OFFICERS FROM OBTAINING ANY POSSIBLE EVIDENCE.**

City Police Reported Incidents

A weekly Crime Report of serious incidents is provided by the Rockville City Police Department to serve as an overview of incidents occurring within the City Limits of Rockville. Please note this summary does not reflect every reported incident that has occurred. Also, the words “arrested” and “charged” do not imply guilt.

ARRESTS

On 05/27/19, a request was submitted to the Montgomery County Police Department’s Special Investigation Division for a male, age 15, to be charged with possession of CDS-marijuana, following an incident that occurred in the 1200 block of First Street.

On 05/27/19, a male, age 24, was arrested for shoplifting, following an incident that occurred in the 400 block of Hungerford Drive.

On 05/28/19, a male, age 25, was arrested for failure to identify oneself to a police officer, resisting arrest, and trespassing, following an incident that occurred in the 700 block of King farm Boulevard.

On 05/28/19, a male, age 37, was arrested for trespassing, following an incident that occurred in the 2200 block of Veirs Mill Road.

On 05/29/19, a male, age 34, was arrested for theft, following an incident that occurred in the 700 block of Rockville Pike.

On 05/29/19, a male, age 52, was arrested for trespassing and disorderly conduct, following an incident that occurred in the 1300 block of Piccard Drive.

INCIDENTS

14900 block of Shady Grove Road, the complainant reported that an unknown subject removed 20 brass fire valve caps from a shopping center between 8:00 a.m. on 05/24/19 and 10:00 a.m. on 05/28/19.

Unit block of Grason Court, an unknown subject gained entry into an unlocked shed between 10:00 a.m. on 05/26/19 and 5:30 p.m. on 05/27/19. Once inside the suspect removed a bicycle.

1000 block of Rockville Pike, the complainant reported that an unknown subject removed two aluminum hubcaps from a vehicle between 7:00 p.m. on 05/27/19 and 10:00 a.m. on 05/28/19.

700 block of Cabin John Parkway, an unknown subject entered a residence through a doggie door between 12:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on 05/28/19. Once inside the suspect removed two video game consoles and a television. The complainant believes the suspect is a known subject who had been staying with the family recently.

400 block of Misty Knoll Drive, the complainant reported that an unknown subject removed two watches and credit cards from an unlocked vehicle between 6:00 p.m. on 05/28/19 and 7:30 a.m. on 05/30/19.

1600 block of Rockville Pike, the complainant reported that an unknown subject entered the business at 7:33 p.m. on 05/28/19. The suspect walked over to the perfume aisle and began removing several bottles from a display, then placed the items into a bag. The suspect then exited the store without paying for the items. The suspect was last seen getting into a gray four door sedan. *The suspect is described as:*

B/F, 5'5", 170 pounds, medium build, long black hair, medium brown skin tone

300 block of Dean Drive, the complainant reported that an unknown subject removed power tools from a vehicle between 8:00 p.m. on 05/28/19 and 10:00 a.m. on 05/29/19.

400 block of Redland Boulevard, the complainant reported that five unknown subjects entered the business between 9:59 p.m. and 10:05 p.m. on 05/28/19. The suspects walked to an aisle and began removing several personal hygiene products. The suspects placed the items into bags, then left the store without paying for them. *The suspects are described as:*

#1 – B/M, thin build, brown eyes, black hair, dark skin tone – Last Seen Wearing: blue/red camo shorts, blue/red camo T-shirt, blue baseball cap

#2 – B/M, medium build, brown eyes, black long hair, beard, dark skin tone – Last Seen Wearing: blue jeans, white T-shirt

#3 – B/M, thin build, brown eyes, black dreadlocks/twists, beard, dark skin tone – Last Seen Wearing: red or red headband, black T-shirt with Adidas symbol in white

#4 – B/M, thin build, brown eyes, short black hair, mustache, dark skin tone – Last Seen Wearing: black shorts, off white/light blue T-shirt

#5 – B/M, thin build, brown eyes, short black hair, facial stubble, dark skin tone – Last Seen Wearing: black sweat pants, black sweat jacket

100 block of Tall Grass Court, the complainant reported that two unknown subjects had entered an unlocked vehicle and removed a house and vehicle key between 4:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on 5/29/19. After the complainant reviewed her home security system, the suspects attempted to use one of the keys to enter the residence but did not make entry. *The suspects are described as:*

2 Unknown race/Males – Last Seen Wearing: hooded shirts, unknown face covering, gloves

200 block of Adclare Road, the complainant reported that an unknown subject entered his vehicle and removed a key fob during the overnight hours on 05/29/19.

1800 block of Rockville Pike, the complainant reported that an unknown subject entered the business between 6:45 p.m. and 6:55 p.m. on 05/29/19. The suspect walked up to a display, removed a pair of shoes, then left the business without paying for the item. The suspect was last seen getting into a Budget Rental truck. *The suspect is described as:*

B/M, 6'3", 180 pounds

700 block of Hungerford Drive, the complainant reported that an unknown subject removed an unattended cell phone between 4:37 p.m. and 8:42 p.m. on 06/01/19. *A review of the video surveillance footage revealed the suspect described as:*

A/M, 5'10", 170 pounds, short black hair – No Further Description
