Dear Customers:

We are writing with great news on the Locker Rooms and Lobby Renovations Project. We are in the “home stretch” of work to ready the indoor pool’s locker rooms and lobby areas for customer use and are tentatively planning to open the freshly renovated entrance, lobby and locker rooms on or about Wednesday 1/22/20. Of course, this date is subject to change, as the next weeks have many important milestones such as equipment checks and fine-tuning as well as final inspections of areas to be re-opened for customer use.

Work on this project has been sequenced to allow customers to begin use of the locker rooms and lobby while progress continues with exterior work such as storm water management areas, landscaping and the parking lot and ancillary areas of the indoor complex. Because the focus of the construction contractor was on making the locker rooms ready, certain interior elements such as the observation room and sauna may not be immediately available on 1/22, however will be opened as soon as they are ready. Customers should expect to see construction continue in and around the facility over the next few months. As such, the section of the indoor facility’s parking lot that is furthest from Martins Lane will be closed for construction work. Overflow parking will be in the outdoor facility’s lot and customers should plan to add a few extra minutes to their travel to/from the indoor pool’s entrance. We will continue to provide porter service from your location in the parking lot to the facility’s entrance if needed through the duration of the project. Customers who desire to take advantage of this service should call the front desk at 240-314-8750 once they are parked to request the porter.

Thank you to our loyal customers who have shown such flexibility and adaptability in continuing to utilize the facility while we undertook major renovations. We hope that the temporary operations alterations and inconveniences during construction are outweighed by the expanded and modernized locker room and lobby areas. To commemorate the facility’s renovations, a dedication ceremony with the Mayor and Council will be scheduled for later this winter. Keep an eye out for details and we hope you can join us.
