



City of Rockville Ethics Commission

Pursuant to Chapter 16, Section 16-3(g) of the Rockville City Code, consonant with the Executive Order issued by the Governor of the State of Maryland on March 12, 2020, “Extending Certain Licenses, Permits, Registrations and Other Governmental Authorizations and Authorizing Suspension of Legal Time Requirements,” and consonant with the State Ethics Commission’s extension of the State financial disclosure statement filing deadline, the City of Rockville Ethics Commission finds that:

1. The suspension of the April 30th deadline for filing financial disclosure statements under Chapter 16, Article III of the City Code (“City Public Ethics Code”), will not endanger the public health, welfare or safety.
2. The temporary suspension of the filing deadline until July 31, 2020 will not deprive any person of their due process rights.

Therefore, notification having been made to the Governor at least 24 hours prior to the effective date hereof, the City of Rockville Ethics Commission directs:

1. The financial disclosure statement filing deadlines imposed by Sections 16-46, 16-63, and 16-68 of the City Public Ethics Code, shall be and hereby are suspended. The deadline for filing financial disclosure statements required by Sections 16-46, 16-63, and 16-68 of the City Public Ethics Code will be extended to July 31, 2020.
2. Reasonable public notice of this Notice be provided, by posting this Notice on the City’s website, distribution via any social media regularly used by the City to communicate with residents; and by posting of this Notice at City Hall.

This Notice shall take effect on April 29, 2020, at 11:59 p.m., and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed by subsequent order or upon expiration on July 31, 2020, whichever is earlier.
