Reopening Montgomery Information

Effective June 1, 2020, the Montgomery County Executive made the decision to enter a modified Phase 1 of Governor Hogan's Road to Recovery. This ends the stay at home order and now it's "Safer at Home." For full details of the County Executive's Order, please go to:

The following precautions are still in place as we move forward.

- **Maintain social distancing by keeping 6 feet of space between you and others.**
- **Wash your hands** often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, **use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.** Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth** with unwashed hands.
- **Avoid close contact** with anyone who is sick.

We recognize that everyone is eager for life to return to normal following the coronavirus, but it is important to exercise caution and recognize this process will take time and a collective effort as a community to reach this goal. Rockville City Police Reported Incidents

The Rockville City Police Department provides a weekly Crime Report of serious incidents to serve as an overview of police activity occurring within the City Limits of Rockville. Please note this summary does not include every reported incident that has occurred during this time frame.

It is to be noted that the words “arrested” and “charged” do not imply guilt.

ARRESTS

06/03/20, a male, age 27, was arrested for burglary following an incident that occurred in the 400 block of College Parkway
