Weekly Crime and Public Safety Information

The Rockville City Police Department would like to provide residents with a few Summer Crime Prevention Tips:

Bicycle/Lawnmower Theft Prevention Tips

- Always lock your bicycle to a stationary object. The best locking device to use is a hardened steel u-shaped lock. (Chains, locks, and cables can be easily cut or broken.)
- Make sure both wheels are locked and remove any accessories that can be easily taken.
- Keep your lawn mower in a locked garage or shed.
- Record makes, models, serial numbers and descriptions and keep this information in a safe place.

Yard Security

- If you are working in the yard, make sure your front, rear, and garage doors are locked.
- Don't keep ladders or other equipment in the yard that could be used to gain access to your home.
- Keep shrubs, bushes, hedges maintained and trimmed so they are not used as hiding places.
- Residential lighting should be used to light up home entry points. Motion detector lights are an inexpensive deterrent for areas where continuous lighting is unnecessary.

Home Security

- Do not advertise your vacation plans. Have a trusted neighbor, friend or relative stop by to check on your house while you are away. Stop your mail and paper deliveries.
- Set timers and place in rooms that you would normally use when you are home to simulate that someone is there during your absence.
