POLICE CRIME REPORT

PROTECTING YOURSELF FROM GAS THEFT

As gas prices rise, thieves are more likely to target your vehicle for its gasoline. To protect yourself, follow these tips:

Park in a well-lit, well-travelled location. In a garage, driveway, or under a streetlight.

Position your vehicle so the fuel door is seen from a main road.

Consider installing a locking gas cap, even if your fuel door locks.

Avoid parking in public places for extended periods of time. Consider carpooling or using transit instead of leaving your car in, for example, an airport parking lot.

Call 911 if you see suspicious behavior. You're not being a burden if you report someone acting strangely around parking vehicles. Larceny arrests and convictions are much more likely if a suspect is apprehended in-the-act.
