## **BUZZED DRIVING IS DRUNK DRIVING**

December is **National Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Month**, as it's one of the deadliest and most dangerous times on America's roadways. Below are facts provided by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration about impaired driving:

**It is illegal to drive with a blood alcohol concentration at or above 0.08%**, and such carelessness led to 10,142 deaths in 2019. Among children killed in motor vehicle crashes, almost one-fifth were killed in drunk-driving crashes and, fifty-three percent of the time, it was the child's own driver who was drunk.

At a BAC of 0.08%, muscle coordination becomes poor, and it's harder to detect danger. At this level, drinkers will find their judgment, self-control, reasoning, and memory impaired, even though they may still only feel "buzzed".

**A single DUI could set you back \$10,000** in attorney's fees, fines, court costs, lost time at work, higher insurance rates, car towing, and more.
