POLICE CRIME REPORT

HOTEL & MOTEL SECURITY

Nothing ruins a summer vacation like a costly or damaging crime in your hotel room. Secure yourself, your belongings, and the integrity of your trip with a few prevention tips:

- Always **bring all your luggage and valuables to your room** upon arrival at your lodging. Thieves may assume guests to their area won't report thefts from unsecured vehicles.
- Bring your money, checks, credit cards, car keys, and valuables from your hotel room or use a hotel room safe.
- As you're searching for your room upon arrival, take a moment to **note the most direct route to and from your room, to the fire escapes, and to elevators.**
- **Unpack and place belongings in the closet and dresser.** Arrange your things so you'll know if anything is missing.
- **Report any lost or stolen items** to the hotel/motel management and to the police.
