BE ABLE TO RECOGNIZE HUMAN TRAFFICKING

January is **National Human Trafficking Prevention Month**, a time to rekindle our efforts against forced labor and the commercial sex trade of millions of men, women, and children. You can help simply by learning some possible signs of human trafficking:

Human trafficking victims can be anywhere, but particularly at **restaurants, elder care centers, salons and spas, agricultural fields, hotels, and construction sites.**

You may learn that victims are **living with their employer, living with multiple others** in cramped or poor conditions, or may **have their employer holding their identity documents.** You may **not be allowed to speak** to a potential victim alone, or their **answers appear scripted or rehearsed.**
