POLICE CRIME REPORT

GIVE TRUCKS & BUSES SPACE FOR WIDE TURNS

Next time you encounter a truck or bus at an intersection, remember: **Trucks and buses have large blind spots and need extra room to swing-wide for a turn.** Be ready with these tips:

Never try to squeeze-by between the curb and a truck or bus with its turn-signal on

To avoid a dangerous and costly collision with a truck or bus, **don't 'block the box' in an intersection** by remaining past the stop-line as traffic is moving

Remain fully behind or fully in-front of a truck or bus for 1 lane on its left or 2 lanes on its right

Don't closely cut into a truck's or a bus's lane: trucks and busses need 40% more time than a car to stop and, moving about 65 mph, require up to 2 football fields of distance

ARRESTS

01/24/23, a male, age 15, was arrested for a weapons-law violation in the 200 block of Richard Montgomery Drive

01/24/23, a male, age 36, was arrested for simple assault in the 1900 block of Henry Road

INCIDENTS

400 block of N Stonestreet Avenue, an unknown subject cut two catalytic converters from a Ford vehicle sometime around 12/21/22. **Incident reported: 01/26/23.**

200 block of Meadow Hall Road, an unknown subject stole a cellphone left unattended between 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on 01/23/23.

Intersection of Monroe Street & Big Oak Court, an unknown subject broke a work-truck's exterior lock, ransacked its interior, and stole tools from inside between 4:00 p.m. on 01/23/23 and 8:00 a.m. on 01/24/23.

1300 block of Rockville Pike, an unknown subject driving a gold Honda Odyssey stole several traffic cones at 9:19 a.m. on 01/24/23.

500 block of King Farm Boulevard, someone drove away in a resident's vehicle (via unknown means) between 6:00 p.m. on 01/24/23 and 3:53 p.m. on 01/25/23.

1600 block of Rockville Pike, two unknown subjects took two bags from a display and used them to steal puffer-jackets and other apparel items. **The subjects are described as:**

Black male—mid-to-late 20s, approximately 5 foot, 7 inches tall, 180 lbs – Last seen wearing: a white zip-up hoodie or jacket, black pants, black sneakers, and a face mask

Black male—with a goatee—Last seen wearing: a black jacket, black pants, and yellow sneakers

Unit block of Upper Rock Circle, an unknown subject who had been pacing around a business suddenly snatched their tip jar while exclaiming "I need this, I need this money!" at 11:48 a.m. on 01/26/23. **The unknown subject is described as:**

Black male—wearing gray pants, black jacket, and a gray and black plaid scarf concealing his face.

2000 block of Gaither Road, office employees found that two checks sent by their company were intercepted in the mail at an unknown time.

Unit block of Choke Cherry Road, an unknown subject shattered a vacant building's front-glass double-doors sometime over the past few months.

1200 block of Rockville Pike, staff at a business found that unknown subject(s) had stolen 30 checks from their mailroom and cashed them at various sites at an unknown time.

400 block of Redland Boulevard, two unknown subjects pushed-out a shopping cart full of merchandise at 7:44 p.m. on 01/27/23. **The subjects are described as:**

Black female—heavy-set, 5 foot, 4 inches tall, dark complexion—Last seen wearing a white hoodie, tight pants/leggings, a white baseball cap, and a denim jacket

Black female—heavy-set, 5 foot, 6 inches tall, dark complexion—Last seen wearing a dark-colored vest, a light-colored bandana, olive-green pants, and a white long-sleeve t-shirt

100 block of Gibbs Street, a patron found that someone had taken his unattended jacket, along with his car's keys and drivers' license, at about 2:00 a.m. on 01/28/23.

600 block of Elmcroft Boulevard, an unknown subject took a patio table from the open between 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on 01/28/23.

1800 block of Chapman Avenue, a resident found that his car was scraped between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on 01/28/23 and believes the damage to be a continuation on ongoing problem.

Unit block of Elmcroft Court, an unknown subject entered a resident's car, strew items about its interior, stole gift cards, and littered ID cards from the owner's backpack between 7:30 p.m. on 01/28/23 and 8:30 a.m. on 01/29/23.
