200 block of Rockville Pike, a bus passenger believes that someone stole the cell phone from his backpack at about 1:00 p.m. on 09/12/23. **Date reported: 10/05/23.**

600 block of Great Falls Road, a student found that his iPhone had gone missing from his backpack, which had been inside his (possibly unsecured) locker, sometime between 1:07 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on 10/03/23.

200 block of Meadow Hall Road, a group of juvenile males had been loitering in a hallway when one of them began discharging a fire extinguisher at 5:46 p.m. on 10/04/23.

300 block of King Farm Boulevard, an unknown subject stole a Hyundai Sonata via (unknown means) sometime between 12:00 a.m. and 7:20 p.m. on 10/05/23.
