I understand that according to the Rockville City Code, Chapter 23, "Traffic", Section 23-27, a permit must be obtained to park any vehicle meeting anyone or combination of the following criteria in a residential zone in the City of Rockville.

1. A rated-load capacity in excess of 3/4 ton but not greater than one (1) ton;
2. A gross vehicle weight (GVW) rating in excess of 10,000 lbs., but not greater than 13,000 lbs., as per the National Automobile Dealers' Association (NADA) used car guide;
3. More than four (4) wheels, but not greater than six (6) wheels; or
4. A width of ninety-six (96) inches.

The following vehicles may not park in a residential zone unless engaged in rendering a service to an adjacent property.

1. A truck, tractor, or trailer;
2. A bus;
3. A vehicle with a rated load capacity in excess of one (1) ton;
4. A gross vehicle weight (GVW) rating of more than 13,000 lbs.;
5. A vehicle wider than ninety-six (96) inches.
