


Project Introduction




Entrance Overview






Intersection Traffic Signal Modification






Senior Center Entrance Driveway Alignment






Storm Water Management Plan






Storm Water Management Plan






Parking Demand Analysis






Parking Demand Analysis





Gate Location






Barrier Option

- Prepare 30% Plan and Present Fourth Advisory Group Meeting

- Revise the concept plan based on comments
- 60% plan submission, review and comment Public Input
- 90% plan submission, review and comment Public Input
- Complete design May 2025
- Construction starts Fall 2025
