

Ordinance No. 15-18

ORDINANCE: To amend Chapter 17 of the Rockville City Code, entitled "Procurement" by amending Section 17-116 entitled "Standard contract provisions" so as to require a provision in City contracts prohibiting contractors from discriminating against any employee or applicant for employment as defined in Chapter 11 of the Rockville City Code; and requiring City contractors to include a provision in all subcontracts prohibiting the subcontractors from discriminating against any employee or applicant for employment as defined in Chapter 11 of the Rockville City Code

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE, that Chapter 17 of the Rockville City Code, entitled "Procurement" is hereby amended as follows:

CHAPTER 17. PROCUREMENT

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ARTICLE V. CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

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DIVISION 1. - GENERALLY

Sec. 17-116. - Standard contract provisions.

Contracts shall include:

(1) Such standard provisions that may be required by any procedures, standards or policies developed by the purchasing agent to implement this chapter.

(2) Such other provisions determined by the purchasing agent in consultation with the using department to be appropriate under the circumstances.

(3) A provision that contractors will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment as defined in Rockville City Code Section 11-2, definition of *Discrimination or to Discriminate*.

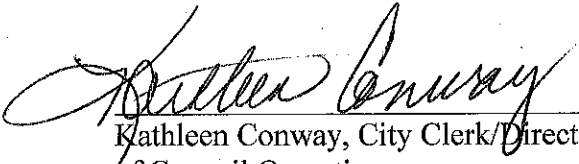
(4) A provision that contractors will include in all subcontracts a provision that subcontractors will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment as defined in Rockville City Code Section 11-2, definition of *Discrimination or to Discriminate*.
