

Ordinance No. 23-09

ORDINANCE:

To amend Chapter 4 of the Rockville City Code entitled "Arts and Cultural Affairs," Article II. "Cultural Arts Commission," Section 4-17. "Members" so as to modify the length of term of appointment for members of the Cultural Arts Commission

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE that Chapter 4 of the Rockville City Code entitled "Arts and Cultural Affairs," Article II. "Cultural Arts Commission," Section 4-17 "Members" be amended as follows:

CHAPTER 4. ARTS AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS

* * *

ARTICLE II. CULTURAL ARTS COMMISSION

* * *

Sec. 4-17. Members.

(a) The Cultural Arts Commission shall consist of eleven (11) members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members should be representative of acknowledged accomplishment or strong interest in one (1) or more art forms, such as the following: architecture, crafts, dance, drama, literature, music, painting, photography, and sculpture.

(b) The terms of all members shall be [two (2)] three (3) years or until their successors take office. A vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of the term for which a member of the Commission is appointed shall be filled in a like manner for the remainder of the unexpired terms for which his predecessor was appointed.

ORDINANCE: To amend Chapter 11 of the Rockville City Code entitled "Human Rights," Article III, "Administration and Enforcement," Division 2. "Human Rights Commission" so as to amend the length of term of appointment for the members of the Human Rights Commission

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE that Chapter 11 of the Rockville City Code entitled "Human Rights," Article III "Administration and Enforcement", Division 2. "Human Rights Commission" be amended as follows:

CHAPTER 11. HUMAN RIGHTS

ARTICLE III. ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT

Division 2. Human Rights Commission

Sec. 11-36. Created.

There is hereby created a Human Rights Commission.

Sec. 11-37. Members.

(a) The Human Rights Commission shall be composed of eleven (11) members. Members shall be broadly representative of the citizens of the City.

(b) The terms of the members of the Commission shall be for [four (4)] three (3) years from the date of appointment and thereafter until a successor has been appointed and qualified. A vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of the term for which a


member of the Commission is appointed shall be filled in a like manner for the remainder of the unexpired term for which the predecessor member was appointed.
