

Resolution No. 1-13

RESOLUTION: To revise and adopt Campaign Policies for City of Rockville

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 3-03, adopted February 24, 2003, the Mayor and Council of Rockville designated the document entitled “City of Rockville Campaign Policy,” dated February 19, 2003, as the campaign policies for City of Rockville; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 11-06, adopted July 17, 2006, the Mayor and Council of Rockville amended the document entitled “City of Rockville Campaign Policy,” so as to allow candidates’ forums for certain non-city elected offices to be televised on Rockville channel 11; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 9-11 adopted March 28, 2011, the Mayor and Council of Rockville amended the document entitled “City of Rockville Campaign Policy,” so as to make it consistent with the guidelines for websites utilizing the “.gov” domain; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 20-11 adopted August 15, 2011, the Mayor and Council of Rockville amended the document entitled “City of Rockville Campaign Policy,” so as to modify the provisions regarding use of city facilities for political purposes; and

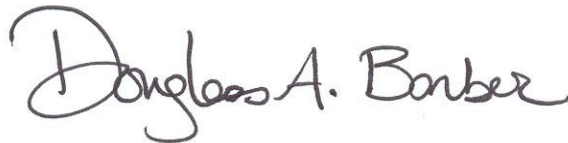
WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has decided to amend the City of Rockville Campaign Policy so as to modify the provisions regarding use of City Hall for political purposes, to explain that the City Seal is copyrighted, to describe the Public Information Office coverage of incumbents running for office, to amend the provisions for parade participation, to remove television coverage by Rockville channel 11 of candidates’

forums for certain non-city elected offices, and to make other minor clarifying and organizational changes to the Policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE, that the document entitled "City of Rockville Campaign Policy," dated April, 2013, is hereby adopted as the campaign policies for the City of Rockville, amending and superseding the "City of Rockville Campaign Policy" dated August, 2011.
