RESOLUTION:

To confirm the recommendation of the Compensation Commission concerning the annual compensation for the Mayor and Councilmembers

WHERAS, pursuant to Section 2-21 of the Rockville City Code the

Compensation Commission submitted a report dated March 20, 2015, containing
recommendations pertaining to the annual compensation of the Mayor and

Councilmembers, and on March 24, 2015, the City Clerk notified the Mayor and Council,
in writing, of the Compensation Commission's report; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2015, the Compensation Commission presented its report and recommendations to the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desires to publicly confirm the Compensation Commission's recommended compensation increases and other benefit recommendations for the Mayor and Councilmembers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE, as follows:

- 1. That the recommendations of the Compensation Commission for compensation increases for the Mayor and Councilmembers are hereby confirmed.
- 2. That the annual compensation of the Mayor shall be \$31,500, and the annual compensation for each Councilmember shall be \$25,500, effective at the commencement of the next term of the Mayor and Council.

- 3. For Fiscal Years 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020, the monetary compensation for the Mayor and Council shall be increased by the positive change, if any, in the Washington-Baltimore CPI-U for the twelve months preceding the previous November.
- 4. That the Mayor and Councilmembers continue to have access to City-offered benefits with 100% of the premiums to be paid by the Mayor and Councilmembers; and
- 5. That the Mayor and Councilmembers continue to be allowed reimbursements for expenses related to official City business under the same policies that apply to City employees.
