Resolution: To endorse the application of Rebuilding Together Montgomery for the FY14 Community Investment Tax Credit Program that will support its Volunteer Home Repair Program

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together Montgomery County (Rebuilding Together) is a local non-profit organization that was founded in 1989 whose mission is to provide repairs for low-income homeowners in Rockville and Montgomery County with volunteer labor; and

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together works to make homes warm, safe and dry, looking at households and families in a holistic way, assessing critical needs such as failing roofs, nonfunctioning furnaces or water heaters, energy efficiency and weatherization, and home modifications that make homes accessible and safe; and

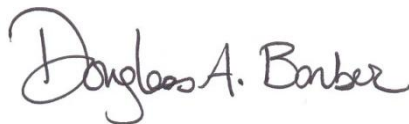
WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together has submitted an application for the FY14 Community Investment Tax Credit Program offered through Maryland's Department of Housing and Community Development, Division of Neighborhood Revitalization, to support its Volunteer Home Repair Program; and

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together's target population is low-income homeowners, primarily the elderly, the disabled and families with children; and

WHEREAS, Rebuilding serves approximately 120 households annually making significant, life-saving repairs for over 1,900 families in its 23-year history and investing \$16.1 million back into our neighborhoods and communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE do hereby endorse the application of Rebuilding Together Montgomery for the FY14 Community Investment Tax Credit Program to support its Volunteer Home Repair Program, improving the homes and lives of low-income residents within the Rockville community.
