*Nothing herein shall prevent the Neighborhood Services Division from issuing a municipal infraction citation for a violation of an order of the Animal Review Official in accordance with Section 3-124(b).

A fine of \$200.00 shall be imposed for the fourth violation of any provision of Chapter 3, whether or not said provision had been previously violated. (For example, if four separate provisions are violated, a \$200.00 fine will be imposed).

MUNICIPAL INFRACTION FINES

For every violation of Chapter 3 that constitutes a municipal infraction, the fine shall be \$1,000.00, the maximum authorized by State law. Each day the violation continues constitutes a separate offense.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall become effective on July 1, 2015.

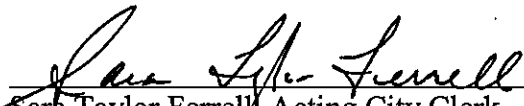
