RESOLUTION:

To support the application of Mobile Medical Care, Inc. ("MobileMed") for participation in the Community Investment Tax Credit Program Through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Rockville recognizes that there is a need for health education and preventive care for low-income residents, as well as a need for the diagnosis and treatment of acute, chronic, and specialized illness among this patient population; and

WHEREAS, MobileMed is a non-profit organization that has been dedicated to providing primary and preventive care to this patient population for many years; and


WHEREAS, MobileMed's proposed Project will expand its healthcare services in the Rockville Priority Funding Area to provide expanded multicultural primary healthcare services and patient education for low-income residents, including diagnosis and treatment of episodic and chronic illnesses; and

WHEREAS, MobileMed has applied to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland ("Department") for approval of the project and an allocation of tax credits for business entities and individuals that contribute to the Project under the Department's Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Rockville is interested in supporting patient education and preventive services for those with limited incomes, including diagnosis and treatment of episodic and chronic illnesses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of Rockville does hereby express approval of the Project and does hereby support MobileMed's application to the State of Maryland for participation in the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.
