Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Rockville adopted pursuant to Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland, Sections 4-303 and 4-304 of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and the Charter of the City of Rockville to amend subsections (h) (i) and (j) of Section 11, "Borrowing Money," of Article VII, "Finance," of the Charter of the City of Rockville by deleting subsection (h) and renumbering subsections (i) and (j) so as to 1) delete the requirement that the Director of Finance cremate or burn bonds and coupons which have been redeemed and paid up to the close of the last preceding fiscal year; and 2) delete the requirement that the cremation certificates be attested to and filed with the Clerk-Treasurer.

Section 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND, that subsections (h), (i) and (j) of Section 11 of Article VII of the Charter of the City of Rockville be amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE VII

Finance

Section 11. Borrowing Money.

* * *

[h. Annually the Director of Finance, or any assistant thereto, shall cremate or burn all of said bonds and coupons which have been redeemed and paid by the Mayor and Council of Rockville and returned to the said Director of Finance up to the close of the last preceding fiscal year. Appropriate cremation certificates, attested to by the Clerk-Treasurer and the Director of Finance, showing the amount of bonds and coupons so destroyed, shall be entered upon the records of the Director of Finance and copies shall be filed with the Clerk-Treasurer.]

[i] h. Nothing contained in this section shall be deemed or construed to impair the terms and conditions of any bonds or other obligations of the City of Rockville issued prior to the effective date of this section.

[j] i. The authority conferred by this section shall be in addition to other applicable authority, including the provisions of public general laws of the State of Maryland, and the Mayor and Council of Rockville shall be entitled to exercise all of the powers therein contained, notwithstanding the provisions of this section.

Section 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the date of the adoption of this Resolution is July 13, 2015, and that the amendment to the Charter of the Mayor and Council of Rockville hereby proposed by this enactment shall be and become effective on September 1, 2015, unless a proper petition for a referendum hereon shall be filed as permitted by law. A complete and exact copy of this Resolution shall be posted in City Hall until August 22, 2015, and a fair summary of this Resolution shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Rockville not less than four (4) times, at weekly intervals before August 22, 2015.

Section 3. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as soon as the Charter amendment hereby enacted shall become effective, either as herein provided or following a referendum, the Mayor and Council of Rockville shall send separately, by certified mail, return receipt requested, bearing a postmark from the United States Postal Service, to the Department of Legislative Reference, the following information concerning the charter amendment: (1) the complete text

of the Charter of the Mayor and Council of Rockville as hereby enacted; (2) the date of the referendum election, if any, held with respect thereto; (3) the number of votes cast for and against the question concerning the Charter amendment, whether by the Council of the Mayor and Council of Rockville or in a referendum; and (4) the effective date of the Charter amendment.

Section 4. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the Mayor and Council of Rockville is hereby specifically enjoined and instructed to carry out the provisions of Sections 2 and 3. As evidence of compliance herewith, the said Mayor shall cause to be affixed to the minutes of this meeting (1) appropriate certificates of publication of the newspaper in which the Title of this Resolution shall have been published and (2) the return receipts of the mailing referred to in Section 3, and shall further complete and execute the Certificate of Effect attached hereto.
