

Resolution No. 13-12

RESOLUTION: To provide for public hearing in connection with the annexation of 10.4060 acres of land, more or less, of Montgomery County, Maryland and the State of Maryland

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 19(b) of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, a resolution has been introduced which, if adopted, would annex the property referenced herein totaling 10.4060 acres of land, more or less, which property is more particularly described in said resolution; and

WHEREAS, it has been verified that the property has no assessed valuation and there are no registered voters residing on the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND, as follows:

1. That the City Clerk is instructed to cause a public notice of the resolution which has been introduced which, if adopted, would annex property of Montgomery County, Maryland and the State of Maryland, to be published not fewer than two times at not less than weekly intervals in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Rockville and the area to be annexed, said notice to specify that a public hearing will be held on the resolution in the office of the Mayor and Council at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as it may be held, on the 10th day of September, 2012, in the Council Chamber, Rockville City Hall, 111 Maryland Avenue, Rockville, Maryland 20850.

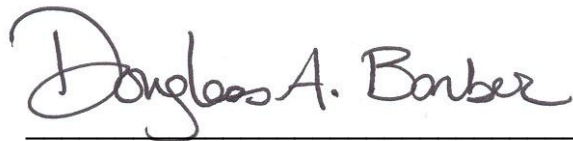
2. That the City Clerk is instructed to provide a copy of the Annexation Plan for the area proposed to be annexed to the County Executive of Montgomery County, Maryland, the Secretary of the State Department of Planning and the Chairman of the

Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission at least thirty days prior to the holding of the scheduled public hearing.

3. That immediately upon the first publication of the public notice of said resolution, the City Clerk is instructed to cause said public notice to be provided to the County Executive of Montgomery County, Maryland, Secretary of the State Department of Planning and the Chairman of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.
