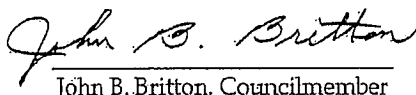

Whereas, not only will Carl R. Henn's footprints linger, they have blazed a trail we should all strive to follow.

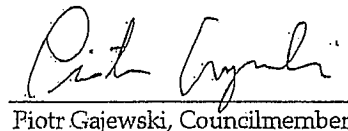

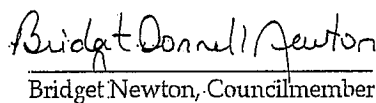

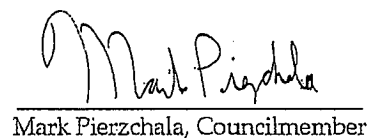
