Resolution No. <u>14A-21</u> RESOLUTION:

To approve a request for a waiver to the requirements of Chapter 21 of the Rockville City Code to reduce the required right-of-way width, and the required pavement width of a secondary residential road for the King Buick development

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 21, Section 21-42(c) of the Rockville City Code, EYA Development, LLC has filed a written request for a waiver of the road construction requirements for new secondary residential roads within the proposed King Buick development, located along the west side of Frederick Road (MD 355) south of its intersection with Shady Grove Road, to reduce the required right-of-way width and pavement width. The right-of-way would be reduced to 51 feet and the pavement width would be reduced to 22 feet in certain sections; and

WHEREAS, after consideration, the City Manager has recommended that it would be in the public interest to grant this waiver so as to allow an adjustment in the requirements set forth in Section 21-64 of Chapter 21 of the Rockville City Code for such construction.
