



Summer 2025 Rockville Rays Swim Team Registration Information

This summer, the Rockville Rays will be competing in Division A of the Montgomery County Swim League (MCSL) along with Stonebridge, Stonegate, Wildwood Manor, Potomac and River Falls.

Our program consists of a series of dual meets divided into two levels of competition. The advanced 'A' meets are limited in the number of competitors per team (meet entries completed by coaches), while the 'B' meets are open to any swimmer not competing in the 'A' meets. We have a full season of Saturday 'A' meets and Wednesday night 'B' meets (dual and intrasquad), so all our swimmers will be guaranteed to have an opportunity to compete in at least one meet each week. Swimmers must be able to swim at least one length of the pool (without stopping) to join the team, as evaluated by the coaches.

VERY IMPORTANT DATES!! These are important dates for the Rays, and we need many volunteers:

- April 1st, Registration opens on rockvillerays.com
- June 6: Parent Orientation Meeting
- <u>June 7, 8am: Time Trials</u>. Participation by all families is needed to help run Time Trials. This meet determines our swimmers' initial seed times. We will need all parents to be available to help run the meet. Please note that only swimmers who have registered and paid their fees can participate in the Time Trials.
- TBD: Relay Carnival; (Rain date TBD) Relay Carnival Window is June 22 July 6
- July 8th: Concessions sales for MCSL Coaches' Invitational Long Course Meet (at RSFC). See volunteer info section of this packet for details.
- July 19th Division Champs at TBD
- July 26-27 All Star Relay and Individual All Star Meets at RSFC

Practice Schedule

Rays Practice starts Tues., May 27th, in the South Pool (indoors at Rockville Swim & Fitness Center).

- Tuesday May 27th until Tuesday June 17th, swim team practice will be from 4pm 5pm (10 and under) and 4pm 5:30pm (11 and older) Mon Fri.
- Wednesday June 18th until July 18th, swim practice will change to 5pm-6pm (10 and under) and 6pm-7pm (11 and older) on Mon, Tues, and Thurs. Friday practices will be 5pm-6pm (for all swimmers) so our Friday parties can start at 6pm.
 - Beginning on 6/17 for the summer season, families should plan on entering the facility from the outdoor pool's entrance and use the outdoor pool's bathhouse to enter the facility for practices.

Registration & Fees

First, visit https://rockvillerays.com and complete the online registration form. After a successful registration, you will receive a "confirmation email." Please take this email (print-out or phone) to the Rockville Swim and Fitness Center to finalize registration. This includes completing the City of Rockville Registration Form and submitting payments to the City of Rockville AND Rockville Rays Parents (more details below). Most of our team communication including swim meets sign-ups, and parent volunteer sign-ups are online. To assure your child's spot on the roster, do not delay in

registration. To attend time trials, registration must be completed, and payments submitted by June 4th. Any registration after June 4th will still be accepted until June 6th; however, those individuals will only be able to attend time trials make-up.

^{*} To take advantage of the special pricing for Rockville Swim and Fitness Center Members, the Rays swimmer must be registered for an active aquatics or full facility membership spanning the entire session of the swim season (25 punch passes are not included).

The Swim and Fitness Center also has a Reduced-Price Membership Program (application available at the Front Desk) which may help individuals qualify for a discounted facility membership that entities them to the member price on the Rays Program.

<u>Transfers to and from the Rays for swimmers who competed on a different MCSL team in the prior season</u>: MCSL has implemented rules and procedures governing movement of swimmers among teams within the league. If a swimmer participated on a different MCSL team in the previous year, or if for some reason a prior Rays swimmer will be joining a different MCSL team for 2025, be sure to check the league's website at https://www.mcsl.org/ for instructions on how to seek approval for a transfer. If MCSL approval is required (see website for details), transfer requests should be submitted by 6/1/2025.

Parent Volunteer Information

Every family on the team is a member of the Rockville Rays Parents group, which exists to support the swim program. Volunteering is required for your child to swim. If parents do not sign-up for at least <u>five</u> volunteer opportunities after registration, with three being an on-deck position, their swimmer will lose the eligibility to be entered in any swim meets. On-deck positions include officiating, timing, and clerk of course. All other jobs are listed on our sign-up website. The Rockville Rays Parents group also staffs a concession stand during several big swim meets this summer at the Rockville Swim and Fitness Center (MCSL Coaches' Long Course, and All Stars), so we need Rays parents to volunteer to sell concessions. The revenue generated from these activities helps support the Rays (purchase equipment, support team activities, etc.)

MCSL offers free classes (see below and on the https://mcsl.org/officials/) for new and recertifying officials. Please seriously consider becoming a Stroke & Turn Official, Referee, or Starter. Parents who are certified as a MCSL Referee or Starter, have two or more years of experience in either position, and serve at least three times in B meets, will be reimbursed the Rockville Rays Parents Club fee of \$100 refunded by July 19th, 2025.

Montgomery County Swim League Code of Conduct and Expectations for Participation

Code of Conduct

As a condition of participation in Rockville Rays, all coaches, athletes, and their parent/guardians/family members (participating adults) agree to follow Montgomery County Swim League's Code of Conduct available at https://mcsl.org/dynamic/code-of-conduct, MCSL Safe Sport Best Practice Guidelines available at https://mcsl.org/dynamic/safe-sport, Rockville Swim and Fitness Center Facility Guidelines, available at https://rockvillemd.gov/2529/Rules-Guidelines as well as posted rules and staff member's instructions.

Communications

Athletes, coaches, and participating adults are expected to always interact with each other in a courteous and respectful manner, including through electronic communications. Except in emergency situations, an adult (18+) may not have one-on-one electronic communications with a minor participant. All electronic communications between an adult and a minor participant should have a second adult included which is suggested to be the minor's parent/guardian (Exceptions: participants who are 18 years of age may communicate with other 15-18 year old participants directly and family members may communicate directly). At any time, should an individual express their preference to cease electronic communication (from non-family members), it must be honored.

Team Suit Information

The Rays team swimsuit this year will be a Dolfin brand in nylon (black) with the team logo. Costs are as follows: Jammer is \$40, Brief is \$26 (no logo), Girls suit is \$49 and prices do not include tax. Team suits are available for purchase from Cassel's Awards & Engraving (703-435-4666 online at https://rockvillerays2025.itemorder.com/shop/home/). Wearing the team suit is strongly encouraged.
