- 7. A Fire Sprinkler System must be installed and inspected prior to occupancy, if required by the Rockville City Code.
- 8. The property is not permitted to be rented without first obtaining a rental license from CPDS, Code Enforcement. The City reserves the right to require that a lease be submitted to CPDS, Code Enforcement within 90 days of the issuance of the rental license. The lease must contain the names of all occupants of the property and must be signed by all parties. Failure to provide the lease within this timeframe may result in revocation of the rental license.
- 9. If occupied as a rental property, the property owner agrees to comply with Chapter 18 of the Rockville City Code and all rental facility requirements, including, but not limited to, the requirement to obtain a rental facility license every two (2) years and have the property inspected.

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I acknowledge that any violations of the Rockville City Code could result in the denial, delay or
revocation of this or other permits/licenses. I acknowledge that any violation of the above
