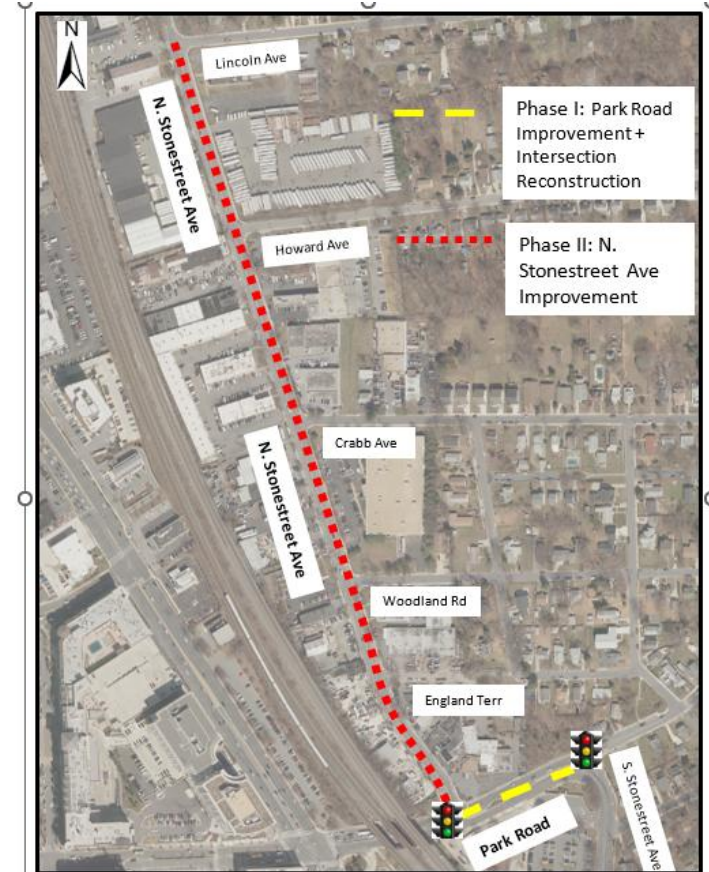

Project Overview

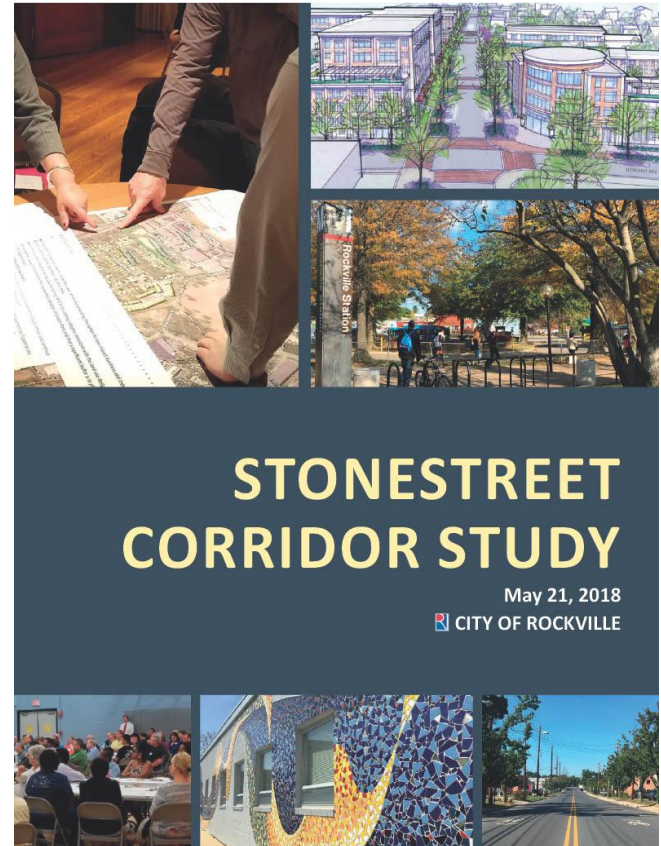
- Complete Streets Project
- Planned as 2 Phases, but implemented together
- Phase 1 – Park Road
- Phase 2 – N. Stonestreet Avenue
- Advances Vision Zero Objectives





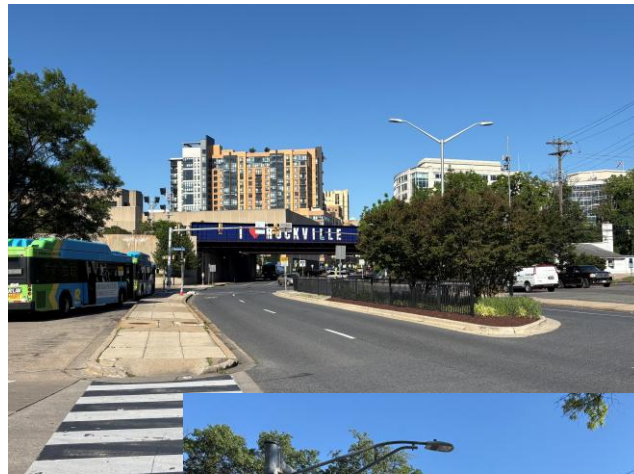
Project History

- Stonestreet Corridor Study completed in 2018
- Aligns with adopted Rockville 2040 Comprehensive Plan
- Federal grant funding – Transportation Alternative Program for the design
- Seeking other funding sources for construction

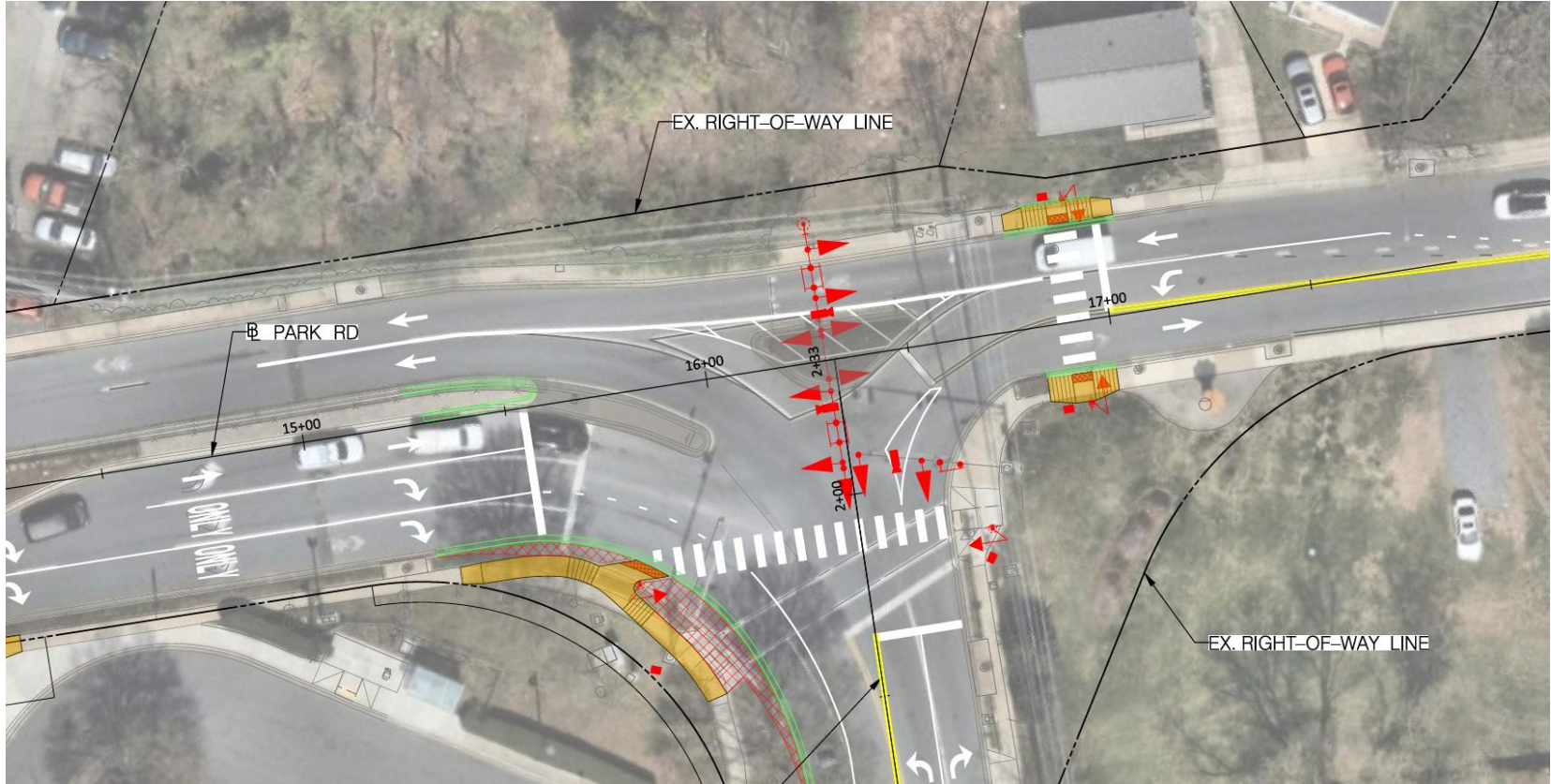


Park Road Proposed Features

- Lane usage will remain unchanged
- Sharrows will continue to be used
- More traditional "T" intersection at S. Stonestreet Ave and Park Rd
- Introduction of pedestrian crossing at intersection for Park Rd



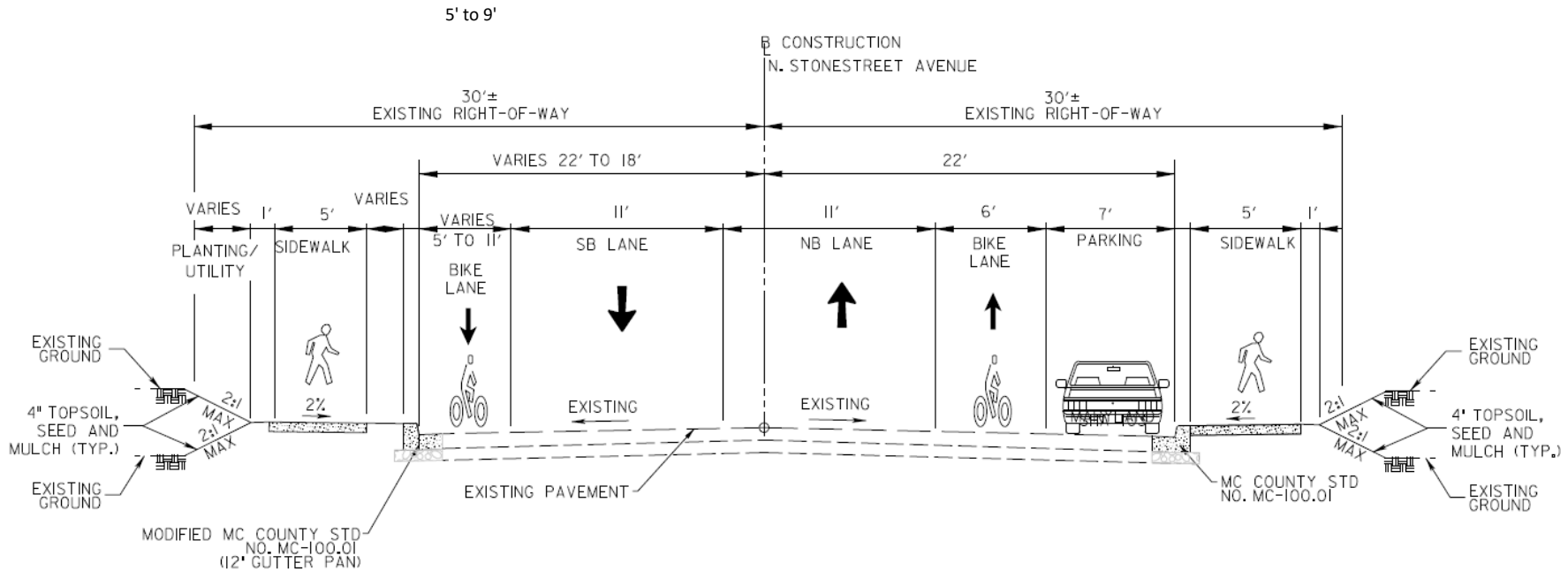
Park Rd and S. Stonestreet Ave Modification

Proposed Typical Cross Section



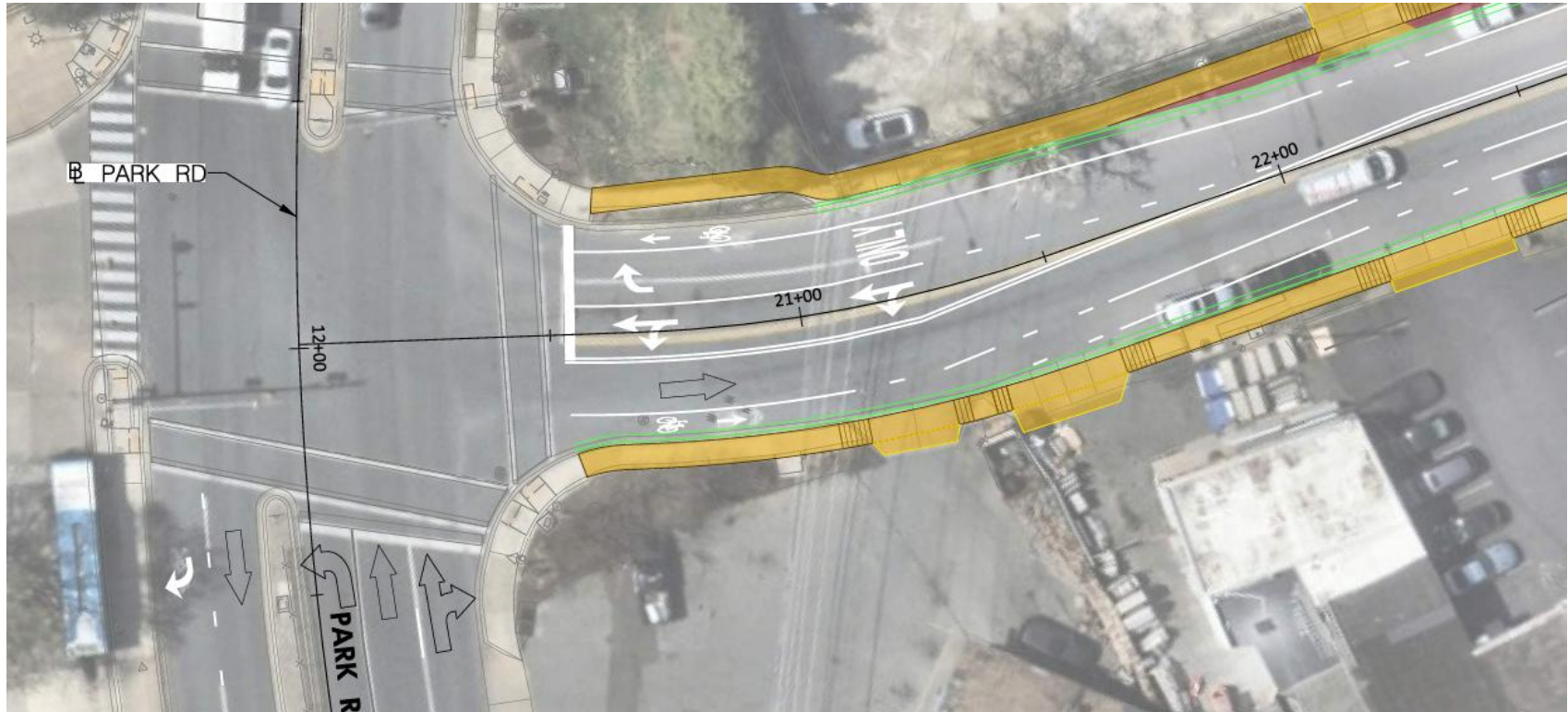
N. STONESTREET AVENUE – TYPICAL SECTION

N. Stonestreet Proposed Features

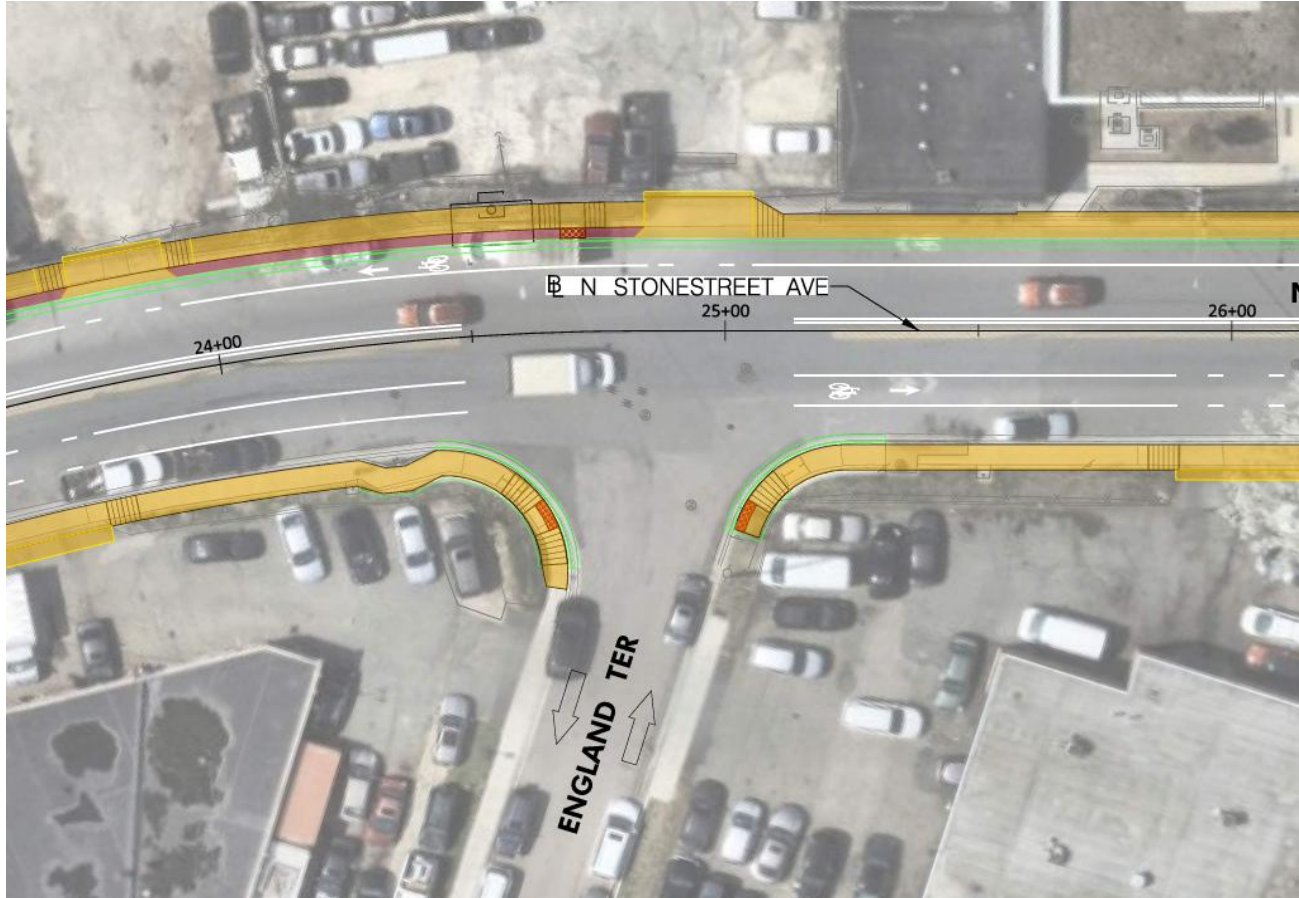
- Two 11 foot travel lanes
- Dedicated Bike Lanes in both directions
- Parking lane on the east side (NB direction)
- Five-foot sidewalk on the east side, buffered from traffic by bike lane and parking lane
- Five-foot sidewalk on the west side, buffered from traffic by bike lane and variable width landscape buffer



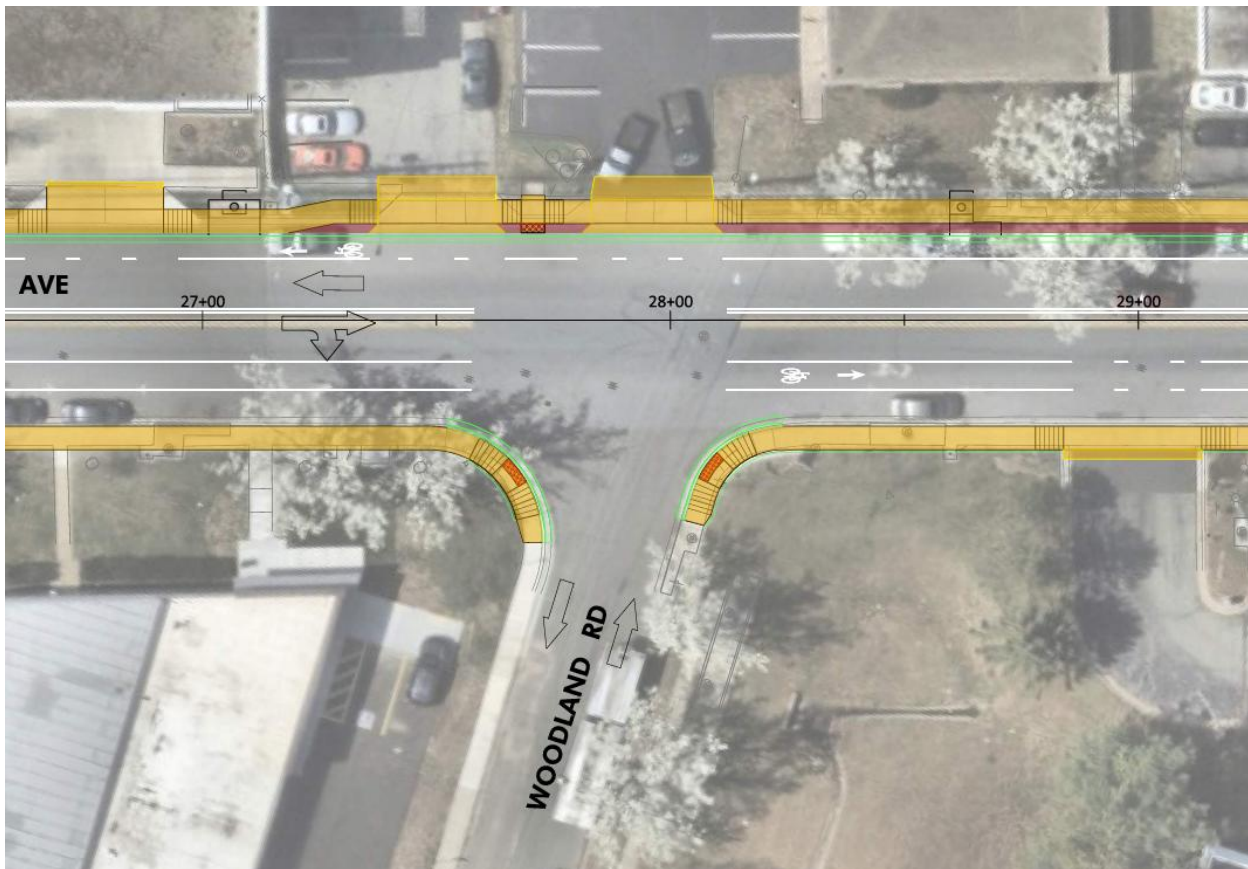
Proposed Layout – N. Stonestreet Ave



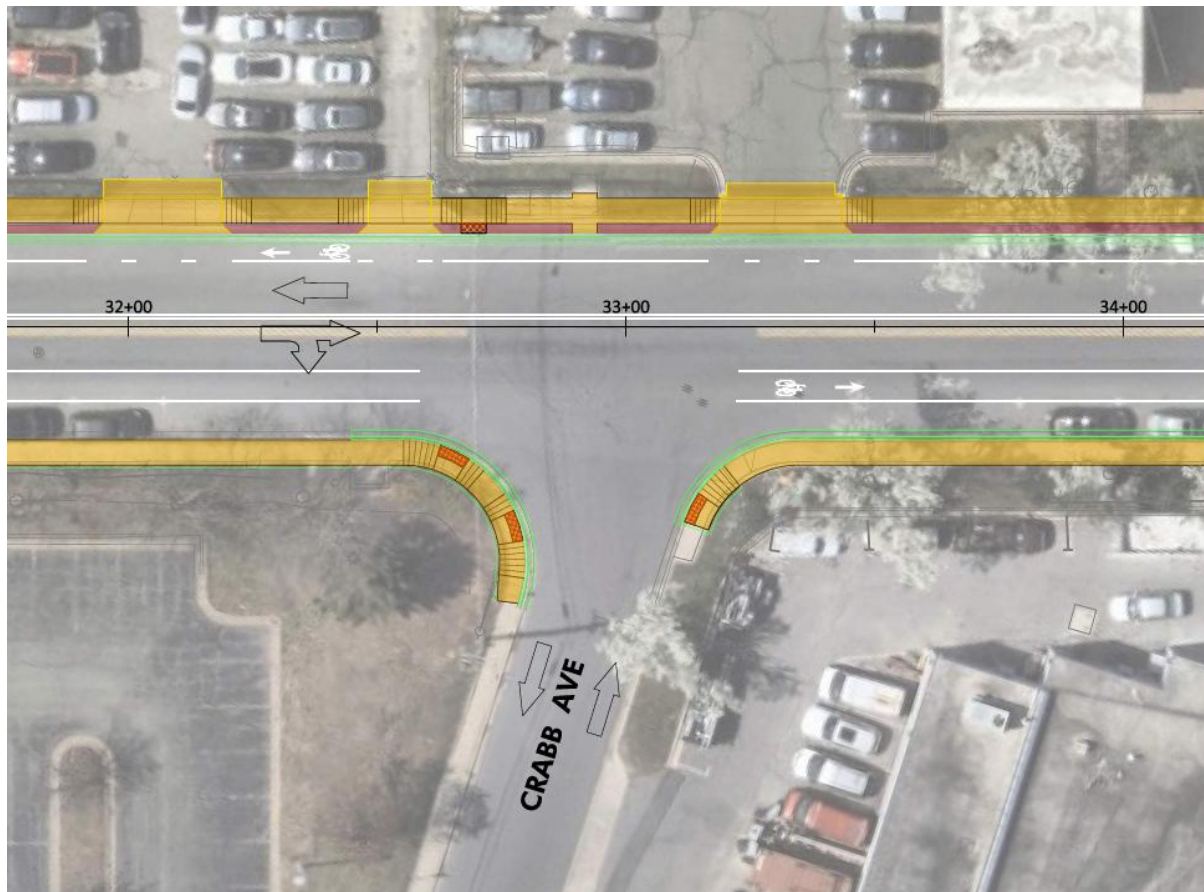
Proposed Layout – N. Stonestreet Ave

Next Steps and Anticipated Schedule

- Engage Property Owners for Easements – Summer/Fall 2026
- Complete plan preparation- Fall 2027
- Construction Bidding – End of 2027
- Construction Contract Award – Spring 2028
- Construction Begins – Summer 2028
