BOIL WATER ADVISORY

E. coli bacteria* were found in the drinking water supply in your area on _____.

These bacteria can make you sick and are a particular concern for people with weakened immune systems. **Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.**

WHAT SHOULD I DO?

DO NOT DRINK YOUR TAP WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST.

Boil water for **at least one minute** and let cool before consuming.

Only use **boiled or bottled water** for drinking, making ice, cooking, brushing teeth, washing dishes and preparing food or infant formula.

**Fecal coliforms and E. coli are bacteria whose presence indicates that the water may be contaminated with human or animal wastes. Microbes in these wastes can cause diarrhea, cramps, nausea, headaches, or other symptoms. They may pose a special health risk for infants, young children, and people with severely compromised immune systems.*
