

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

FLUSH YOUR PLUMBING

On _____, a water main break in your neighborhood caused temporary loss of water service and increased the risk of drinking water contamination.

As a precaution, customers should flush their household plumbing after service has been restored.

WHAT SHOULD I DO?

1. Turn on a cold-water faucet on the **lowest floor** of your home.
2. Open additional cold-water faucets **one at a time** from the lowest floor to the highest.
3. Let the water run for **at least five minutes**.
4. Flush refrigerator water and ice dispensers.

WHY IS FLUSHING IMPORTANT?

Water main breaks can allow dirty water enter pipes. Even after repairs and disinfection, a risk of contamination may remain.

WHAT IS THE CITY DOING?

Water samples will be tested for bacteria. If E. coli is present, a boil water advisory will be issued and affected customers will be notified.

AVISO IMPORTANTE SOBRE EL AGUA POTABLE

Una rotura en una tubería principal de agua en su área puede haber provocado un mayor riesgo de contaminación del agua potable.

Una vez que se restablezca el servicio, abra los grifos de agua fría de su vivienda durante al menos 5 minutos para permitir el ingreso de agua fresca y tratada. Enjuague también los dispensadores de agua o las máquinas para hacer hielo del refrigerador.

Se están realizando pruebas al sistema de agua y se emitirá un aviso de hervir el agua si se detecta la presencia de E. coli.

重要饮用水通知

您所在地区发生主供水管道破裂事件，可能导致饮用水 受污染风险升高。

供水恢复后，请打开家中冷水水龙头持续放水至少 5 分钟，排出管道内积水，引入新鲜的处理水。冰箱饮水机或制冰机也需同步放水冲洗。

相关部门正在开展水质检测，若检出大肠杆菌，将发布沸水警告。
